Dear NSW Government,

These are my views:

[1] REGISTRATION

All engineers who are involved in signing-off of designs or operational-readiness of systems, should be registered as a CPEng, nationwide.

And these registrations should be made mandatory enforced by relevant laws. In other words, a company cannot deliver a design to its clients unless the works are checked and sign-off by a registered CPEng in that discipline.

[2] IMPARTIALITY OF REPORT

The government should engage a 3rd party independent engineers to perform assessments on designs or operational-readiness of systems to ensure they are fit for purpose and safe for the public. To maintain the assessors' independence, government should engage them directly and the engineers shall receive payments from the government directly. These engineers shall submit their assessment reports directly to the government, copied to relevant stakeholders.
