RETAIL TRADING ACT 2008 DECISION

REASON FOR DECISION

1. I, Fiona Hayman, am an officer delegated by the Secretary under the *Retail Trading Act 2008* to exercise the functions prescribed in that Act.

On this day I have decided to grant an application, received 3rd April 2021 from IMB Ltd trading as Hunter United pursuant to section 14(I) of the *Retail Trading Act 2008*.

2. This exemption applies subject to the condition that IMB Ltd trading as Hunter United, may only extend its Broadmeadow, Glendale, Green Hills and Charlestown branches on 22nd May 2021 to open between 9:00am – 5:00pm having regard to:
 - (a) It is in the public interest for Hunter United to extend hours on 22nd May 2021 having regard to the interest of the employees who work on this bank close day.
 - (b) The approval to open on 22nd May 2021 does not include those which are otherwise a restricted trading day – Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or Anzac Day before 1pm. On these restricted trading days the branch is to be closed.
3. My reasons for this decision are subject to the following:
 - (b) all labour engaged on 22nd May 2021 (will be voluntary in accordance with section 14(F) of the *Retail Trading Act 2008*
 - (b) IMB Ltd trading as Hunter United will adhere to the provisions of the relevant industrial instrument in relation to staff who work on 22nd May 2021
4. This amendment to existing exemption takes effect on the 22nd May 2021.
