Re: Retirement Village exits entitlement and recurring charges

I am a resident in a Retirement Village and am most concerned.

In March 2019 the Minister responsible for retirement villages, Matt Kean, gave an election promise that, if elected, a Liberal/National NSW government would change the retirement village exits entitlement and recurring charges.

On 9 July 2019 the Hon Kevin Anderson released a discussion paper inviting submissions from the public as to how the Government should proceed with its intention to introduce them.

In the discussion paper it refers to "grandfathering". I read this as the fact that current residents of a retirement village would not be eligible for any entitlements or recurrent charges cap under the law.

This seems most unfair and appals me greatly.

Would you be able to present my concern when the bill is presented in Parliament.
