Time frames

Applications will generally take 30 business days to process once Fair Trading receives the completed application with all mandatory information and supporting documents. Some licence types may take additional time due to checks which must be completed with external agencies.

Request for additional information

If we need to request additional information to assess your application, we will contact you via SMS or email. Please note that this will increase the processing time.

Approved applications

If your application for a licence is approved, we will send you details of your licence via email and your approved licence details will be published on the public register.

Refused applications

If your application is refused, we will contact you in writing and outline the reason(s) for the refusal, as well as details of your options. If we refuse your application, you are eligible for a refund of the application fee, less the non-refundable processing component.
