Bijay Maharjan	BDC3196	<ol> <li>Disciplinary Grounds under sections 45(c)(iii) and 45(l) of the <i>Building and</i> <i>Development Certifiers Act 2018</i> (NSW) (Act).</li> <li>In relation to section 45(c)(iii) of the Act, Registered Certifier breached section 253, 254 and 307C of the <i>Crimes Act 1900</i> (NSW) (Crimes Act).</li> <li>In relation to section 45(l) of the Act, the Registered Certifier engaged in improper and unethical conduct.</li> <li>On 25 October 2022, the Registered Certifier lodged an application for 'Building Surveyor – Restricted – All class of buildings' and within that application provided false referee statements that he had prepared himself.</li> <li>On 11 January 2023, he provided NSW Fair Trading with additional documentary material in response to a Notice of intention to refuse registration. Contained within that additional documentation were false referee statements and false experience inspection reports that he had prepared himself.</li> </ol>	Pursuant to section 48(1)(e) of the <i>Building and</i> <i>Development</i> <i>Certifiers Act 2018</i> (NSW), cancel the registration of the Registered Certifier; and Pursuant to section 48(1)(f) of the <i>Building</i> <i>and Development</i> <i>Certifiers Act 2018</i> (NSW), permanently disqualify the Registered Certifier from being registered in any class under the Act.	20 February 2024
