I quite strongly disagree that it is necessary to change the existing standards of engineer registration. It is very rare for building problems that arise after construction to be due to design deficiencies. Defects are almost always due to poor building work and the problem lies in the fact that there is no enforced system of construction monitoring. Some councils try to encourage construction supervision by insisting that Inspection and Test Plans are provided as part of the CC process but nobody checks at the end of the job to see if the plans were followed. It is these and related problems that need to be addressed – not more bureaucratic harassment of engineers who already have to attain high standards of education and professional development.
