Information for applicants

- You should complete this application form if you are applying for: a **new** paintball marker permit, or **renewal** of an existing paintball marker permit.
- The applicant must be at least 18 years of age.
- There is one flat fee, regardless of the length of permit selected.
- Complete all applicable questions. If information is missing, we may ask you to supply the required information and/or documents to support the application. Failure to supply information and/or documents can delay a decision on your application.
- A NSW paintball marker permit is not required in NSW if you are the holder of an equivalent authorisation (as described below) for a paintball marker, which is not suspended or cancelled, and you are not residing in NSW for a continuous period of more than 3 months:
 - an adult firearms licence issued in the category of paintball marker under the *Firearms Act 1996* of the Australian Capital Territory,
 - a licence for a category A weapon within the meaning of the *Weapons Act 1990* of Queensland,
 - a licence for a category A firearm within the meaning of the *Firearms Act 2015* of South Australia,
 - a Category A firearms licence within the meaning of the *Firearms Act 1996* of Tasmania,
 - a paintball marker licence within the meaning of the *Firearms Act 1996* of Victoria,
 - a licence for a subcategory E5 firearm issued under the *Firearms Act 1973* of Western Australia.
